Response to Proposal to Permanently Change Burnie Rosters

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has consulted with members about Lifeblood's proposal to permanently change the Burnie Donor Centre operating hours.

Following that consultation, the ANMF has written to Lifeblood to outline members' concerns in relation to issues about the maintenance of current terms and conditions and of employment and sought assurances about equalisation processes that might be required. The ANMF has requested Lifeblood respond by **close of business Thursday 24 November 2022**.

The ANMF will keep members updated on the response and next steps.
