Respect Aged Care Tasmania

Fred French Home

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) met with members at Respect Fred French on Tuesday 13 December 2022. Members raised the following issues:

- Vacant shifts are being offered only to a select few staff. This has impacted on staff morale and a feeling of division has resulted.
- Staff meetings have been cancelled or postponed, members are uncertain around how to raise issues in the workplace.
- Serious workplace incidents are perceived to be dismissed by management.
 - The ANMF has raised these issues with Respect Fred French Facility Manager Scott Rigby.
 - Scott Rigby has replied to these concerns as follows:
 - "Staff are allocated daily by the Clinical Manager considering skill mix, COVID management etc, allocations are checked in the morning for S/L replacement and any other changes.

Staff meetings have been cancelled due to COVID outbreaks, sick leave or staff not showing up. Scott has reiterated that his door is always open to discuss <u>any workplace concern.</u> This also applies to the Clinical Care Manager.

Scott was disappointed to hear that staff felt management did not follow up with serious workplace incidents, he stated that staff that were involved/witnessed a recent incident have been approached, and the clinical team has put into place a plan moving forward."
