Uniting AgeWell has Agreed to Postpone the Ballot

Further EA Meetings to be Scheduled

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) advises that after a hearing in the Fair Work Commission, the employer has agreed to:

- a) Withdraw the ballot for a new agreement; and
- b) Meet with Bargaining Representatives on Tuesday/Wed next week – time/place to be confirmed.

It is hoped that the employer will listen to and take seriously, the concerns raised by members about the draft agreement.

If the meeting is not useful and productive discussion can not be achieved, the ANMF will contact members to decide what steps they may wish to take in support of an agreement which is acceptable to them.

Further updates will be provided once the meeting(s) have occurred.
