The ANMF Lodge a Dispute in the Fair Work Commission

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has been strongly advocating for members working at Calvary St Vincent's and their significant workload concerns and unsafe staffing practices. The ANMF despite raising these concerns multiple times via formal correspondence, has not received one written response that actually addresses members' staffing concerns, with Calvary insisting on not wanting to respond in writing.

Calvary suggested that the Workload Consultative Committee meeting was the forum for discussions on workloads and that the minutes of this meeting would form their response. Despite this commitment and the ANMF requesting on numerous occasions, the minutes for the last meeting have not been circulated.

The ANMF has now lodged an application with the Fair Work Commission to discuss the numerous and significant workload concerns of members working within St Vincent theatres below the Australian College of Perioperative Nurses (ACORN) standards, as per the current edition. We are currently waiting on a conference date to be set, once this has been confirmed, the ANMF will relay this information to members.
