Uniting AgeWell Enterprise Agreement Ballot – Vote No!

The employer has again decided to put its proposed new enterprise agreement out to ballot without the ANMF's agreement. The proposed agreement document will now be distributed by Uniting AgeWell for your consideration prior to a ballot. The ANMF encourages all members to **vote no** to this proposed agreement, which would remove paid meal breaks in exchange for a wage offer that is well below cost of living increases.

and

CLOSES: 1600 hrs on Wednesday 29 March 2023
