

## **ANMF EA UPDATE 6**

## Calvary Health Care Tasmania Nursing Staff Enterprise Agreement

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) met with the employer on Wednesday 8 March 2023 to bargain for a replacement Enterprise Agreement (EA). The employer provided the following response to the ANMF Log of Claims (LOC):

- 3 year agreement with nominal expiry date of 1 July 2025.
- Wage and allowance offer not yet provided.
- New special maternity leave provision to provide 12 weeks' paid leave in the event of stillbirth.
- No in charge allowance for Level 2 nurses.
- No professional development allowance.
- No increase to penalty rates.
- No paid meal breaks except as set out in current agreement.
- No penalty rates for paid meal breaks.
- No right to have a meal break between the 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> hour of a shift.
- No additional tea break per shift.
- No increase to overtime penalty rates or change to Nurse Unit Manger (NUM) overtime arrangements.
- No increase to annual leave entitlements.
- No increase to paid parental leave.
- No superannuation on unpaid parental leave.
- No staff-patient ratios.

The ANMF is very concerned that the employer has rejected so many member claims. The employer did not agree that nurse workloads were excessive, did not agree that NUM overtime provisions were unreasonable, and argued that current meal break provisions were working well. The ANMF is meeting with members to discuss the offer.
