

## **ANMF NEWSFLASH**

## **Royal Hobart Hospital Emergency Department** March 2023 Benchmarking Update

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) attended a Benchmarking meeting for the Royal Hobart Hospital (RHH) Emergency Department (ED) on Thursday 9 March 2023.

The Nursing Hours Per Patient Day (NHpPD) eCalculator – ED and ED Short Stay tool has been used to calculate the proposed nursing hours. At this stage the tool has not been applied to the ED Short Stay and as such this unit has not yet been formally Benchmarked.

The following proposed increase in Full Time Equivalent (FTE) is for the ED alone.

- 1. A direct care uplift on the Morning Shift from 21 FTE to 27-28 FTE
- 2. A direct care uplift on the Afternoon Shift from 22 FTE to 28-29 FTE
- 3. A direct care uplift on the Night Shift from 18 FTE to 22-23 FTE
- 4. A indirect care navigator position uplift from 2.95 FTE to 4.79 FTE

An ANMF member's meeting has been arranged for next **Thursday 23 March at 1500hrs**. Members will receive further details via an SMS reminder. ANMF Workplace Representatives (WREPs) will be available on the day to assist in facilitating the meeting. Please note this meeting will include a vote on endorsing the Benchmarking, which is open to ANMF members only.
