Group Director Change Proposal "Final Decision"

To date, the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has written, on three occasions, to the Executive Director of Nursing (EDON) with member feedback at the group director and Director of Nursing (DON) level in relation to a change proposal that has ultimately resulted in the implementation of a change in eligibility for the group director role, despite the majority of the feedback submitted being <u>against</u> the change.

The change now implemented will see all group director positions moved to the Health and Human Services Award (HAHSA) award at band 9, when positions become vacant. Prior to this change, the group directors were attached to a dual classified position with the Nurses and Midwives and Allied Health Awards.

At this stage we are waiting for a response from the EDON to specific questions in relation to the following:

- 1. How this change will affect on-call. Specifically in relation to flow on impacts with how this change will impact the DONs, Nurse Unit Managers (NUMs) and team leaders.
- 2. Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) registration and concerns that group directors will no longer be linked to a clinical award.

The response is due **Wednesday 29 March 2023**. In the meantime, the ANMF wish to hear from our members in the wider Statewide Mental Health Service community. As such we are asking members to please let the ANMF know if this change has been communicated to **YOU**. If not and if members have any concerns, feedback, or questions in relation to this.
