# Respect Aged Care Coroneagh Park

## Workload Issues

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has been contacted by members at Respect Coroneagh Park who raised workload concerns. The ANMF has formally raised these concerns on behalf of members. The concerns include but are not limited to:

- Blue Gum staffing. Rostering for the afternoon shift, there is only 1 care worker rostered between 2100hrs and 2300hrs for the secure unit.
- The overhead hoist is now kept in the locked Care Manager's office.
- Digital Enhanced Cordless Telecommunications (DECT) phones – many are in an unusable state.
- Maintenance requests and testing and tagging of equipment are not actioned in a timely manner.
- There is a lack of clear communication.

The ANMF has suggested some solutions to address member concerns and requested formal feedback from management by **close of business Thursday 27 April 2023**. Once the response is received, the ANMF will then schedule a meeting with members to discuss the details and seek members' clarification and future direction.
