Statewide Mental Health Service Adult Community Mental Health Service Acute Care Team Multidisciplinary Allowance Approved!

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has been notified today (Wednesday 3 May 2023) that the Multidisciplinary Allowance (MDA) for grade 5 nurses working in Adult Community Mental Health Service Acute Care Team (ACT) has **finally been approved!** This is after quite a significant delay and a significant push by the ANMF to have Statewide Mental Health Service (SMHS) apply the MDA to this team. It is safe to say that without the ANMF's involvement this outcome would not have been achieved.

For affected members, the ANMF has been told that payment will be processed as soon as practicable but should be seen in the coming weeks. We encourage members to contact the Member Support Team, if there are any further questions about this payment, however, the timing will be in the hands of the pay office who are very short staffed.
