# Rosebery Community Health Centre Good News

Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) officials successfully advocated for members working at Rosebery Community Health Centre (RCHC) between 12 December 2021 and 11 December 2022 who were financially disadvantaged due to not being rostered a mix of shifts.

We are pleased to report today that the Deed of Release has been finalised and that affected members can expect to start receiving their deeds indicating their back pay amount this week. We encourage members to sign the Deed and return it as soon as possible. Once the Tasmanian Health Service (THS) have received the returned Deed, payroll will be instructed to make the payments in next pay period.
