## **Regis Aged Care**

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) attended a bargaining meeting with your employer on Tuesday 19 September 2023.

The employer recognised the clear message members sent by voting down the last offer.

Regis has now agreed that the afternoon and night shift penalty rates would be retained and has agreed to put the wage offer to the ANMF in writing so members can discuss the full offer.

A scheduled negotiation meeting with the ANMF is planned on **Thursday 19 October 2023**.

ANMF organisers will visit workplaces in the coming weeks to discuss the full offer and to take feedback from members.
