West Coast District Hospital Roster Proposal 12-Hour Shift Proposal

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian branch (ANMF) continues to work with the West Coast District Hospital (WCDH) DON/ NUM on behalf of members with regard to vacant FTE in the roster period October-December 2023.

The ANMF has been advised that WCDH has had ongoing hard to fill RN/EN positions, in particular RN staff who are skilled to work as the RN in charge of shift after hours that requires oversight of the Emergency First Response Unit (EFRU), subacute and aged care areas.

As a result, the WCDH DON/NUM have proposed to continue the current roster of 12-hour RN/EN shifts until 9 December 2023, a period of 8 weeks.

The ANMF seeks to understand members' concerns, if any, and requests your feedback on the proposed rosters. You may read the full change proposal here.
