Enterprise Agreement

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) attended a meeting with your employer on Monday 18 December 2023 the third in a series of meetings. The clauses discussed so far relate to workload, major changes and various types of leave including compassionate, parental, vaccination and family and domestic violence leave.

The next meeting is planned for **Monday 15 January 2024**, agenda items for discussion will be union delegates leave, allowances, superannuation, and shift penalties. The ANMF will provide an update following the meeting.

To date your employer has given no indication as to what wage increases will be offered, that should be known early February 2024, the ANMF will schedule member meetings immediately after to provide updates and seek members feedback on the offer as a whole.
