Launceston General Hospital (LGH) - ICU Electronic Workload Form

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has developed an electronic workload form for our ICU members to record workload, skill mix and redeployment concerns. The information collected will be used to identify shortfalls in staffing and themes driving member concerns in ICU.

1. **Access the Survey:**

Click on the following link to access the electronic workload form survey: LGHICUWorkloadSurvey.

2. **Save as an App on Your Phone:**

For iPhone Users:

- Navigate to the survey link <u>LGHICUWorkloadSurvey</u>.
- At the bottom of the screen, tap the share icon (square with an arrow pointing upward).
- Scroll down and select "Add to Home Screen."
- Customise the app name if desired, then tap "Add."
- The survey will now be accessible as an app from your home screen.

For Android Users:

- Go to the survey link <u>LGHICUWorkloadSurvey</u>.
- Tap the three dots in the upper-right corner to open the menu.
- Select "Add to Home screen" or "Install [browser name]."
- Customise the app name if needed and tap "Add" or "Install."
- The survey will now be saved as an app on your home screen.

3. **Completing the Survey:**





- After saving the survey as an app, simply tap on the app icon from your home screen to access it conveniently.
- Complete the survey at your convenience, especially after shifts that have raised workload concerns.
- The survey will be open indefinitely, allowing you to submit your feedback when it suits you.
