The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has been notified by Regis that the Enterprise Agreement Vote was a **NO** vote in the recent ballot. The ANMF congratulates members on making a stand on an unfair offer by Regis.

The ANMF has requested that Regis recommence negotiations immediately for the ANMF to continue to negotiate towards a better agreement for all members.

The ANMF will be organising member meetings to talk to members about the next steps which can include members taking Industrial Action via a Protected Action Ballot (PAB). Please continue to check your inboxes for details.

The ANMF will discuss the PAB at these member meetings and via updates.
