Parkside Work Health and Safety Concerns Response from THS

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF), on behalf of members from more than one department working at the Parkside Building, raised significant work health and safety concerns with THS management and with the regulator WorkSafe.

WorkSafe has advised that the matters observed did not meet the standard required for the issue of an improvement notice at this time.

The ANMF has been advised that interim alternate offices have been sourced for some departments, with more to follow if necessary.

The full THS response <u>here</u> outlines how the concerns have been or are being addressed, **if the answers are contradictory to what you are experiencing, please contact your manager in the first instance and advise the ANMF via our member support team so we can take further action.**

The ANMF thank members for raising these concerns, we will continue to monitor progress.
