## General Agreement

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) is informing members that the General Enterprise Agreement (Agreement) has been put out to ballot by Corumbene.

Members should have received a draft agreement to read from Corumbene, informing them that the voting period is opening on Thursday 15 February 2024, and closing on Thursday 29 February 2024.

The ANMF has attended member meetings prior to the draft being put out and members have expressed their dismay at the Agreement being put out to ballot when they feel more negotiating could be done.

The ANMF has not endorsed the Agreement and encourage members to read through the draft and vote NO if they are not happy with the changes and the offer on the table.
