Good News - ANMF members win separate Agreements

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) advocated on behalf of members to retain separate agreements rather than combining the current two agreements. On Friday 12 April 2024, the ANMF received notification that the employer has forwarded for review two agreements. Whilst the agreements have been negotiated side by side and provide similar or the same industrial protection for all, the ANMF is pleased to notify nurses and care workers that your voice has been heard. Nurses will retain the right to vote on their own conditions. The ANMF will now review both agreements to ensure it matches the negotiation process following which access periods and vote dates will be provided to all.

Congratulations to all ANMF nurse and care worker members at Tandara Lodge - together you have achieved the outcome important to you.
