

ANMF EA UPDATE 14

Regis Aged Care Ballot

Negotiations for the *Regis Aged Care, ANMF & HACSU Enterprise Agreement - Tasmania 2023* have ended and all eligible employees will now have the opportunity to vote as to whether they want to accept the new agreement.

Voting:

COMMENCES:	9 am Tuesday 28 May 2024
CLOSES:	12 noon Friday 31 May 2024

Summary of employer offer:

• Lump sum payment for ENs and carers:

FTE	Lump Sum Payment (\$) (gross)
Full-time	\$2,500
Above 0.75 but less than FT	\$2,000
Above 0.5 to 0.75	\$1,000
0.25 to 0.5	\$800
Less than 0.25	\$500



• Wage increases.

- 6 weeks paid parental leave for carers (status quo for nurses).
- Public holiday penalty rate increased to double time and a half for carers.
- Removal of the allowance in lieu of paid meal break after a three month 'transition' period (note that the employer is continuing to pay this allowance during negotiations, but is not required to pay it under the current EA).
- Public holiday penalty rate reduced to double time for nurses.
- Afternoon shift penalty rate for carers reduced from 15% to 10% for shifts commencing at 10 am and before 12 noon and finishing at or after 4 pm.
- New early night shift for carers 10% penalty for shifts commencing at 4 am and before 6 am.
- Nurses' paid meal breaks not to be counted as time worked and not to include any penalties.
- Reduction in Monday to Saturday overtime penalty rate for the first two hours from 100% to 50%.
