

ANMF EA UPDATE 2

Health Care – NWPH Enterprise Agreement Bargaining

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) received a response from your employer on Monday 6 August 2024. The initial offer falls far short of members' claim for safe staffing as well as for wages - 3% per year for a 3 year agreement is the offer. At a member meeting on Monday and via survey responses, ANMF members' claims for a move to ratios that provide for safe staffing taking into account minimum staffing for night shift is extremely important to you. **We have heard you**, at the next bargaining meeting the ANMF will advocate on your behalf for what is important you - **competitive wages and safe staffing**.
