Mistral Place, Tolosa Street, Roy Fagan Centre and Millbrook Rise Centre 12-Hour Shifts

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has received correspondence from THS management regarding the 12-hour shifts changes and back pay as follows:

1. Back Pay – back pay has been actioned for all current staff and was paid on 10 July 2024 for the period up to 11 November 2023.

The Department has requested former employees and casual staff contact them via the People Connect Portal. The Department states there is no record held within payroll of former employees or casual staff to identify who may be eligible.

The ANMF is willing to contact the Department on behalf of members if required. Please send details to the email address below.

Any members who have received backpay are invited to send in their timesheets and payslips for the ANMF to scrutinise that this has been paid correctly.
