OneCare Nursing Employees

Ballot Results

A majority of staff have voted Yes to the OneCare Ltd Nursing Employees Enterprise Agreement 2023.

OneCare has advised the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) that 78% of votes cast voted Yes to the new agreement. OneCare will now lodge the agreement with the Fair Work Commission for approval.

In a smart move, that recognises your commitment and dedication, OneCare will be providing you with the benefits without waiting for Fair Work Commission approval!

OneCare advises:

- The new payrates effective from the first full pay period in July will be implemented as a priority. These new payrates will be paid in next weeks' payroll processing.
- The backpay will be processed in a separate pay run by the end of November.

Please let us know if you experience any issues associated with payroll implementing the new pay rates.
