Caseload Midwifery Enterprise Agreement Negotiations: Update to ANMF Members

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) want to provide you with an update regarding our ongoing advocacy for the Caseload Midwifery Enterprise Agreement. While the Department of Health has acknowledged the concerns raised by the ANMF on your behalf, we are deeply disappointed with their lack of urgency in addressing these critical issues.

In their latest response, the Department stated they are awaiting advice from the State Service Management Office before scheduling a meeting to progress negotiations. While they have reiterated their commitment to resolving these matters, we believe this delay reflects a failure to prioritise the needs of midwives in the Midwifery Group Practice.

This drawn-out process is unacceptable. We will continue to push for meaningful discussions and urge the Department to act with the urgency that this matter demands.

We thank you for your resilience and support as we navigate this frustrating process. Your input remains invaluable, and we encourage you to share any further concerns or feedback. Should a response not be provided imminently, the ANMF will lodge an application with the Tasmanian Industrial Commission seeking a resolution to this protracted bargaining process and an offer that seeks to IMPROVE the current caseload agreement!
