We Need Your Input for the 2025-2026 State Budget Submission

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) is preparing our submission on your behalf for the 2025-2026 State Budget. Submissions are due on **Friday 20 December 2024**, and we need **your feedback** on key priority areas. Your voice is essential to ensure the solutions we propose truly reflect the needs of nurses, midwives, Assistants in Nursing (AINs), Registered Undergraduate Students of Nursing (RUSONs) and Registered Undergraduate Students of Midwifery (RUSOMs) across the Public Sector.

We know the challenges you're facing, and this is your opportunity to tell us what you need to help fix them. Please take a few minutes to complete our short survey.

Areas of focus to consider and include in your survey feedback are:

1. **Staffing Needs** – See below some examples of specific needs that you may wish to include in your response:
 - *More community nurses to support patients transitioning home after acute care.*
 - *Extending community dementia services to reduce acute admissions.*
2. **Recruitment and Retention** - See below some examples of specific needs that you may wish to include in your response:
 - *Market allowances for hard-to-fill positions or services.*
 - *Clinical coaches in every ward and unit.*



- *Increased numbers of Clinical Nurse Educators (CNEs).*

3. Service Delivery and Infrastructure - See below some examples of specific needs that you may wish to include in your response:

- *24/7 services (e.g., pathology, radiology, pharmacy, and allied health).*
- *Expanded Hospital in the Home and virtual care beds.*

Whatever you think will make a difference, we want to hear it. Your input is invaluable in shaping solutions we can present to the Government.
