Negotiations Update

Your Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) organiser will be onsite at 1400hrs on **Wednesday 29 January 2025** to seek members' views regarding the latest offer. All members are encouraged to attend.

Healthe Care management have clarified that under its revised workload management offer, the theatre nurse unit manager's hours will all be counted as management hours.

Since staff voted to reject the proposal that went to a vote in October 2024, management have:

- revised Appendix B Principle of Workload Management; and
- offered a new classification for specialist enrolled nurses.

The ANMF is seeking feedback from members on the latest offer.
