

ANMF EA UPDATE 7

Wintringham

Agreement Voted Up

A majority of voters in the staff ballot voted to endorse the proposed Wintringham Collective Agreement 2024. Management has advised the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) that 443 employees voted, with 419 in favour of approving the agreement, from 1056 eligible voters.

Wintringham will next file the Agreement with the Fair Work Commission (FWC) for approval.

Nurses Work Value Wage Increases

Separately to the wage increases provided for in the Enterprise Agreement (EA), there are wage increases for aged care nurses this month as part of the Aged Care Work Value Case.

The amount of the work value wage increases depends on your classification level. These wage increases take effect from the first full pay period on or after 1 March 2025. If you have any questions or queries regarding these wage increases, please contact us.
