

ANMF EA UPDATE 6

Healthscope - Hobart Private Hospital

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) will be attending a bargaining meeting with Healthscope on Friday 28 March 2025 to progress negotiations for the Healthscope Tasmania Nurses and Midwives Enterprise Agreement 2025.

This follows management delaying the meeting to allow it to work on a downsizing exercise to give effect to the decision to close maternity services at Hobart Private Hospital.

The ANMF has also been focused on supporting maternity staff in recent weeks and has been advocating for a fair and transparent process.

It is important that bargaining proceed, noting that the current Enterprise Agreement (EA) reached its nominal expiry date on 31 December 2024 and Hobart Private staff are overdue for a pay rise.
