## Update on Access to Consumables and Non-Consumables

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has received a formal response from management regarding our concerns about recent changes to access to consumables and non-consumables across the Royal Hobart Hospital.

Management have **disagreed** with our assertion that consultation was required prior to these changes, stating: "These operational adjustments do not affect core clinical supplies or the standard patient meal service."

## The ANMF strongly disagrees

We believe these changes have directly impacted nurses' ability to provide safe, quality care to patients – including nutritional care. These changes have disrupted essential nursing work practices.

**Nurses have a professional obligation to ensure patients receive adequate nutrition** – this is a fundamental requirement of our care. Limiting access to basic consumables and supplies has compromised our ability to meet this responsibility.

Management has now requested **specific examples** of when nurses have been **unable to provide basic nutrition** due to these changes.
