As you may be aware, Healthscope – the private hospital operator of several facilities across the country, including Hobart Private Hospital – is facing significant financial challenges.

We understand this is an extremely uncertain and distressing time for our members working at Healthscope facilities, and we want to assure you that the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) is here to support and protect you throughout this period.

What ANMF is doing:

- **We are today writing to Healthscope's Chief Executive Officer (CEO) and the Tasmanian Health Minister**, seeking urgent information and assurances regarding the ongoing operation of Healthscope hospitals and the protection of your jobs and entitlements.
- **We are actively engaging with State and Federal Governments** to ensure continuity of patient care and to advocate for the security and wellbeing of all ANMF members working within Healthscope.
- **We have created a comprehensive Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) document**, available today on your **ANMF Member Portal**, to address common questions and concerns.

- **We will be hosting member webinars** in the coming days to provide updates and answer any questions you may have (details to follow shortly).
