Primary Health North Allambi Services Change Proposal Received

Following our recent request the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has received a Change Proposal document which confirms the Tasmanian Health Service (THS) decision to relocate 10 primary health services to Cimitiere House.

Unfortunately, the Change Proposal document has not provided any strategies that will address the concerns raised by members which include issues around staff and client safety. Further, it appears the inherent requirements of the different teams impacted by the relocation has not been taken into consideration when the ANMF reviewed the proposed layout of Level 3 and 4 of the chosen relocation site.

Therefore, the ANMF has requested an opportunity to view the proposed building and discuss the layout with the impacted teams, so the feedback provided is pertinent to the services impacted. The ANMF has requested the date to which feedback can be provided be extended until **close of business Thursday 10 July 2025**, which has been granted.

Members affected by the relocation are urged to provide feedback, attend information sessions, and request the opportunity to view the building/layout to enable constructive feedback to be given.
