Do Your Tasks Go Beyond Grade 4? Help the ANMF Build the Case for Reclassification

After holding a number of meetings with members at the Department for Education, Children and Young People (DECYP) members have expressed they would like **the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF)** to assist them in seeking to formally pursue **reclassification of the School Health Nurse (SHN) role** within the **DECYP** on the basis that current duties and responsibilities significantly exceed the scope of a Grade 4 classification.

To support this process, we are inviting all nurses working in the **DECYP** to complete a survey outlining the tasks you regularly perform that align more closely with Grade 5 descriptors, including:

- Leading complex case management and care coordination.
- Practising autonomously across multiple school settings.
- Contributing to policy development, service design, and working parties.
- Mentoring staff, facilitating professional development, and providing education sessions across the multi-disciplinary team.
- Providing clinical leadership and health promotion across school communities.
- Interpreting and applying policy across health and education systems.





• Supporting students with complex medical, psychosocial, and trauma-related needs.

The information you provide will help the ANMF build a robust, evidence-based case to present to the Tasmanian Health Service (THS). Your input is essential in ensuring that the classification of the role accurately reflects the **advanced clinical practice, autonomy, and leadership** you provide every day.
