Allambi Services - Change Proposal Feedback Closes

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has provided a final submission on behalf of members in the Allambi building change proposal, following our initial correspondence which raised the significant concerns from members around the proposed relocation to the Cimitero Street premises.

The infrastructure team/decant project officer will now collate all the feedback submissions, looking at the common themes and concerns raised. It is anticipated consultation meetings will occur with affected staff and their unit managers to address the concerns raised during the feedback phase.

ANMF members are encouraged to make themselves available at the time these consultation meetings occur, so you remain fully informed of the proposal.
