North West Regional Hospital Operating Suite

ANMF Members plan to return to the Tasmanian Industrial Commission

The ongoing workload dispute in the North West Regional Hospital (NWRH) Operating Room Suite (ORS) was to be heard on Tuesday 29 April 2025 in the Tasmanian Industrial Commission (TIC). On Monday 28 April 2025 the Tasmanian Health Service (THS) committed to funding the Full Time Equivalent (FTE) of 7.35 increase for a 12 month period. 11 weeks later the positions have not yet been created, and the workload concerns have not been addressed. Members have contacted the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) to report double shifts, mandatory ALS training cancelled and excessive use of casuals to fill roster vacancies leaving short notice leave to be covered with overtime or double shifts.

The ANMF have heard you, we will return to the TIC on **Thursday 31 July 2025 at midday** for a conciliation/directions hearing before President Barclay.

We want to thank members and delegates who have continued to stand with their union to enforce members' entitlements and secure safe staffing levels. The ANMF remains fully committed to our members.
