# Royal Hobart Hospital Medical Imaging Member Update – Meeting Held 6 August 2025

Thank you to all members who were able to attend the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) member meeting on Wednesday 6 August 2025.

The ANMF provided an update on the current Step 2 Grievance, confirming that the matter is now progressing to Step 3. As part of this process, witness statements will be required. These statements are a crucial way to demonstrate how the department is failing to meet its duty to provide safe, sustainable workloads.

To support this process, the ANMF has developed a confidential survey, which remains the best method for members to provide specific details about their experiences. This information will help us build the strongest possible case to ensure workload pressures are properly addressed and eased.

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During the meeting, members also discussed the change proposal to extend department hours. While members are not opposed to the extension in principle, significant concerns were raised about how this will be implemented with current staffing levels. Members agreed that additional staff must be in place before any extension of hours is enacted.

As a next step, members are requesting that the Tasmanian Health Service (THS) provide a draft roster to show how the extended hours would be staffed, including the on-call roster, to ensure transparency and clarity about what resourcing is required.



Thank you once again to those who attended. Your continued engagement empowers the ANMF to advocate for the changes needed to support the hardworking nurses and staff within Medical Imaging.
