Emmerton Park

Voting Closed – Ballot Results – YES

Voting for the new Emmerton Park Incorporated Staff Agreement closed **1600hrs** on **Monday 1 September 2025**. The Ballot saw 53 Emmerton Park workers turning out to vote on the new agreement.

The outcome of the vote is **YES**:

Eligible voters	142
Yes votes	36
No votes	17
Total valid votes	53
% Yes	67.92%

What Happens Next?

The proposed Emmerton Park Incorporated Staff Agreement will now be sent to the Fair Work Commission (FWC) for approval. The new agreement will commence seven (7) days after approval by the FWC.

Once the Enterprise Agreement (EA) is approved by the FWC, the agreed increases and other gains achieved in the EA will be enforceable.
