We, the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (**ANMF**), are pleased to provide an update in relation to recruitment for the North West Regional Hospital (NWRH) Operating Suites (**ORS**).

Your Nurse Unit Manager (**NUM**) has informed us that **shortlisting** of suitable candidates for the additional 7.35 Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) nursing staff is moving forward this week as planned.

We are advised that once candidates have been assessed, shortlisting can take a few days as the process is outside the direct control of the ORS.

For candidates progressing to the next stage, we understand that **interviews** are/will be booked for next **Thursday 18 September 2025**.
