Allambi Change Proposal V2

Glaring Omission

On Wednesday 8 October 2025, the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) received a subsequent Change Proposal to supplement the original Change Proposal published Friday 6 June 2025 regarding the decanting of employees from the Allambi site to accommodate the necessary groundwork for the Hospice project to proceed.

It appears that after considering the extensive feedback from the first Change Proposal the original plan to accommodate all of Primary Health North (PHN) staff on Levels 3 and 4 of Cimitiere House would not be suitable, therefore, a second Change Proposal has been published.

The second Change Proposal, which includes the business support and PHN management staff, indicates this cohort of staff will be located on Level 2 of Cimitière House.

Once again, an open planned office layout is suggested. Considering the high-level sensitive conversations that will occur in these teams the suggestion of using the meeting rooms on levels 3 and 4 may seem to be an oversight, when these spaces will also be occupied by teams delivering clinical services to the community.
