Launceston General Hospital Wombat Ward - Step 1 Grievance Lodged

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has lodged a Step 1 Nursing Hours per Patient Day (NHpPD) Workload Grievance on behalf of members working on **Wombat Ward at the Launceston General Hospital (LGH)**.

This grievance follows significant concerns raised by members regarding staffing shortages, increasing workloads and an increasingly junior workforce. The grievance formally requests that the **Tasmanian Health Service (THS)** take action to address workload concerns and meet its obligations to prevent sustained and unreasonable workloads. Members will be updated as the grievance progresses. Your ongoing feedback and examples of workload impacts remain important and valued.
