Calvary Health Care Tasmania St Vincent's and St Luke's Hospitals

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) wrote to the Calvary Hospital general manager on behalf of members about the recent changes occurring at both Calvary Hospital campuses. Our letter outlined the changes that members have raised concerns about.

Disappointingly Calvary management have not kept the ANMF abreast of the changes proposed and this has made it very difficult to provide accurate advice to our members.

Last Thursday evening an email was received from Calvary general manager which outlined some key developments around theatre services. This email states all surgical activity is now operating from St Vincent's while lists will be extended and include from Saturday 25 October 2025 *pending surgeon and staff availability*.

To assist with managing the reduced theatre access and to guide practice principles a new Clinical Committee has been formed under the guidance of Fiona Lee.

Further, Calvary has proposed to move all medical wards to St Luke's from **Wednesday 5 November 2025** with negotiations to have an HMO available at St Luke's 24/7.

It appears all the assessment reports for St Luke's have been received, the ANMF looks forward to receiving an update on the outcomes as soon as possible.

Further, a FAQ document was developed, the ANMF has requested to receive a copy of this document.
