Allambi Relocation

The ANMF lodges a TIC Application

Following the announcement that 10 primary Health services were to be relocated to an inner-city location and the concerns Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) members raised about that location, the ANMF has felt compelled to take this matter to the Tasmanian Industrial Commission (TIC).

Despite, what appears to have been extensive feedback about the relocation of these services the Tasmanian Health Service (THS) has pushed ahead with the plan to relocate critical primary health services to what many consider to be an inappropriate location.

The ANMFs application is based upon the genuine opportunity to influence the outcome before a final decision is made, that is *fait accompli*, therefore genuine consultation did not occur.

An application to the TIC was accepted and the hearing has been listed for Tuesday 11 November 2025 at 0900hrs.
