Aged Care Work Value Case Increase

Wages in Aged Care are increasing as a result of the Aged Care Work Value Case in the Fair Work Commission (FWC). The next instalment of work value wage increases for nurses and carers was due from the first full pay period after Wednesday 1 October 2025. The increases funded by the Federal Government vary depending on your classification level and pay point.

During the Enterprise Agreement (EA) bargaining process Emmerton Park management made a commitment to maintain wages by a percentage above the Award. Pleasingly they have honoured that commitment. The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has been provided by Emmerton Park with details of how the increase has been applied to each eligible employment category. Please check your latest pay advice to ensure that the increase has been applied to your pay.
