Southern Cross Care Tasmania Rosary Gardens Closure Update 3

URGENT ANMF Action Required: Survey on Rosary Gardens Closure Strategy

The closure of Southern Cross Care Tasmania (SCCT) Rosary Gardens is unacceptable to the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF), the residents, the staff, and the local community. We are fighting this decision with everything we have, but to be successful, we need to know exactly how you want to take action.

Your willingness to participate in industrial, political, and public actions will determine the strength and direction of our campaign.

ACTION REQUIRED: COMPLETE OUR CONFIDENTIAL CAMPAIGN STRATEGY SURVEY

We ask that you complete this short survey **immediately** and **no later than Friday 21 November 2025**.

The survey can be completed anonymously and will be used solely to plan our next steps, including setting a date, time, and location for a public rally.

Why Your Feedback Is Vital

- **Confidentiality:** This survey is administered externally to ensure your responses cannot be traced back to you. We encourage you to be completely frank about your preferred actions and concerns.



- **Action Planning:** We need your input to choose a rally date and time that ensures maximum attendance from workers (across all shifts), residents' families, and community supporters.
- **Strategic Direction:** We need to know which industrial and public actions you are prepared to participate in to apply the strongest possible pressure on SCCT and the Government.

Your ANMF Organiser, Peter McBeath will be on-site for an ANMF Member Meeting on **Monday 17 November 2025 at 1300hrs** in the downstairs staffroom to provide feedback on the initial survey results and to discuss our collective campaign strategy.
