

ANMF EA UPDATE 1

Corumbene Nursing Home

Through Enterprise Agreement (EA) bargaining we can make Corumbene the best possible place to work.

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) will soon be bargaining for new EAs to replace the:

- Corumbene Nurses Agreement; and
- Corumbene General Agreement.

These EAs both reach their nominal expiry date on Thursday 30 July 2026.

The ANMF will soon be running a Bargaining Priorities Survey to identify the items members would like to put forward for the new Agreements. Please look out for this survey.

Work Value Wage Increases

Wages across the Aged Care sector have been increasing in recent years due to the *Aged Care Work Value Case* in the Fair Work Commission (FWC). These wage increases are being fully funded by the Commonwealth Government.

The latest phase of wage increases for nurses and carers arising from the *Aged Care Work Value Case* were due from the first full pay period on or after Wednesday 1 October 2025. [Government Guidance](#) makes clear that these wage increases are in addition to wage increases under EAs, and EA bargaining is expected to continue in the usual way.



The ANMF has asked Corumbene for information to allow us to verify that it has correctly applied the work value wage increases, however, Corumbene is yet to agree to provide this information to the ANMF.

We will keep you updated and may seek further information from members to ensure we understand your current wage rates.
