Grievance Accepted by Tasmanian Industrial Commission

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) is advocating strongly for members in the **Continuing Care Teams** in the South, a unit within Statewide Mental Health Services. We're pleased to inform you that your grievance has been accepted for consideration by the Tasmanian Industrial Commission (TIC).

What's the grievance about?

- **Unsustainable and unreasonable workloads**
- **Multi-disciplinary allowance** payable to eligible members
- **Resource modelling** to ensure adequate mental health service delivery

The grievance hearing is scheduled for **Monday 12 January 2026**. We will keep you updated on the outcomes of this hearing and next steps, so look out in your emails for more information.
