Have Nurses Missed out on the Aged Care Work Value Case Wage Increases?

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) received enquiries from nurses employed at Meercroft indicating that they were not included in the recent wage increases from the Aged Care Work Value Case (ACWVC).

The guidance material from the Australian Government to Aged Care Providers clearly indicates they expect **all** workers covered by the ACWVC to receive the wage increase at the time the decision was made as these wage increases have been funded by the Australian Government.

Further, the guidance material states *the usual enterprise agreement bargaining should continue to occur, separately, to the additional funding provided.*

The ANMF is seeking to understand if this wage increase is isolated to a select few or is it more widespread? Therefore, the ANMF is asking our nursing members, employed at Meercroft, to complete a short snap poll so we can ascertain if you are owed any money from missed wage increases.
