



ANMF NEWSFLASH

Royal Hobart Hospital Department of Medical Imaging Tasmanian Industrial Commission 12 March 2026

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) attended the Tasmanian Industrial Commission (TIC) today (Thursday 12 March 2026) alongside the Tasmanian Health Service (THS) to continue conciliation regarding the Department of Medical Imaging (DMI).

The THS provided the ANMF with an update prior to our appearance in the TIC to advise the requested uplift in nursing establishment has been approved by the THS secretary to increase DMI Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) levels by an additional 6.48 FTE to the new higher amount of 23.08 FTE. The THS are in the process of formally creating positions and commencing the recruitment process. The THS also requested to be able to proceed with the change proposal which is currently on hold due to the status quo.

Given this information was received today (Thursday 12 March 2026), the ANMF has requested additional time to consult with members to discuss: How will the actual uplift in numbers be allocated?; How that will this be reflected with the change proposal?; What modelling with roster and shift times will look like?; How do we move to a shift worker model with extended hours?

The THS were agreeable to the ANMFs' request. The status quo currently remains.

The matter has been **adjourned to Tuesday 14 April 2026 at 1000hrs.**



The ANMF will be in touch with members very soon to arrange meetings to seek feedback prior to representing to the TIC in April 2026.

The ANMF will keep members updated as further information is received and consultation dates are confirmed.
