Continuing Care Teams

Tasmanian Industrial Commission 12 March 2026

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) attended the Tasmanian Industrial Commission (TIC) today (Thursday 12 March 2026) alongside the Tasmanian Health Service (THS) to continue conciliation regarding the Continuing Care Teams (CCT) – Statewide Mental Health Services Unit.

Following consultation with members, the ANMF confirmed to the TIC that members are agreeable to proceed with modelling at this stage.

During the conference, the ANMF sought an update on the status of the modelling work. The THS advised that the modelling data was received last week and is currently being collated and formatted. The THS indicated they anticipate being ready to present the modelling to staff, union representatives, delegates and members during the week starting **Monday 23 March 2026**. These meetings will commence formal consultation and include discussion of extended hours, operational risks, and associated strategies, with feedback to be sought from the ANMF, delegates, and members.

The President of the TIC reiterated expectations that these meetings occur promptly and involve all relevant parties.

The matter has been **adjourned to Monday 20 April 2026 at 1200hrs**.

The ANMF will keep members updated as further information is received and consultation dates are confirmed.
