Public Sector Emergency Departments Transfer of Care Data Requested

As the **Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF)** prepares to return to the **Tasmanian Industrial Commission (TIC)** on **Friday 24 April 2026** to continue the dispute regarding the proposed reduction of **Transfer of Care (ToC)** to 45 minutes across the State's **Emergency Departments (EDs)**, we are seeking member feedback to strengthen our case.

The Tasmanian Health Service (THS) continues to assert that the strategies in place make this reduction safe and effective. However, their own data suggests otherwise, with 45% of Category 2 patients and 52% of Category 3 patients across the state not seen within recommended timeframes during the week of 21–27 March 2026.

Please continue to complete SLRS reports where you feel patient wait times are adversely affecting care. This evidence will be critical, and the ANMF can seek access to this data during proceedings in the TIC.

Your ongoing feedback is essential to ensure **the ANMF** can accurately represent the severity of member concerns. We ask that all members complete this short shift survey - it can be completed each shift. While we have kept it concise, it captures key information to support our advocacy. You do not need to answer every question - any information you can provide will assist in protecting nurses, patients, and the Tasmanian community.
