Invitation to Participate in Service Review

The Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation Tasmanian Branch (ANMF) has received correspondence from Tasmanian Health Service (THS) Nursing Director - Primary Health North informing us that a review into referral pathways for some intermediate services will be undertaken.

The review is to explore if a single point of referral is appropriate for services such as Community Rapid Response Service, Hospital in the Home, Rapid Access Inreach Service and the Launceston Community Nursing service.

The communication provided indicates that *staff will be engaged throughout the review through usual communication and feedback mechanisms and through working groups.*

Should the review propose to change any roles/responsibilities or workforce structures then the THS has committed to *consultation in accordance with our industrial obligations.*

Members are urged to keep themselves up to date with the review and the recommendations by way of workplace communications and to provide feedback where they feel it is appropriate.

The ANMF will ask THS Nursing Director Primary Health North to be included in the communications provided to staff.
